Dear families,

Happy Friday everyone! What a busy little week it has been! On Monday, we were so proud of our children as they took part in our short act of Remembrance and held a two-minute silence.

Our theme for the coming weeks is **Starry**, **starry night!** Children will be learning about space, planets, rocket and aliens. They will be listening music by composer Gustav Holst called 'The Planets Suite' and they will be inspired by the artist Van Gogh and his famous painting called Starry Night.

As usual, here are a few reminders...

Invoices

Just a reminder that your '30 hour code' does not cover the cost of breakfast club, lunch club and after school club. Please check your invoice to make sure your payments are up to date. The amount still owing will be **highlighted in yellow** on your invoice. Many thanks.

Snack Fund

It's that time again, folks! Snack Fund is due for this half term, **payable by cash.** The charge is £12.00 per half term. Please pass your child's payment for this half-term to a member of staff in your child's class team as soon as possible.

School Photographs

The school photographer is visiting us on **Tuesday (19th November).** He will be taking individual photos of the children that you will be able to purchase. These should arrive in school before Christmas. Please send your child into school as you wish them to be photographed on the day.

Sugar Awareness Week

Next week is Sugar Awareness Week. You can support our work in school by talking to your child about which foods and drinks contain high amounts of sugar and teaching them that too much sugar is harmful for teeth and general health. Children will receive a **free drinking bottle** as part of this campaign for home. Children are able to access chilled water in school throughout the day so **do not require water bottles in school**.

Winter coats

Please ensure your child has **a nice warm coat with a hood for school**. Children require the additional warmth of a winter coat.

Hats, scarves, gloves and umbrellas not appropriate for school. Hats, scarves and gloves go missing and also restrict a child's ability to play outdoors. Children are very active outdoors and staff will continually monitor the weather conditions to adjust outdoor learning sessions to meet the prevailing weather conditions.

Attendance and Timekeeping:

As a maintained nursery school, we follow the safeguarding procedures and policies of Liverpool City Council. As such, any **unexplained absences may be followed up as a safeguarding concern.**

If your child is going to be late or absent from school for any reason, please telephone the school office on the first day. If your child is ill, please keep them at home and contact us to let us know the nature of their illness and a likely return date.
